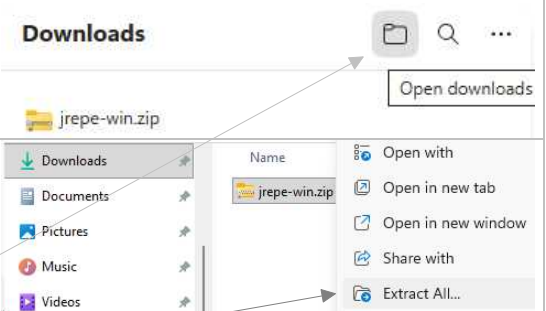


jRep-INSTALLATION for Windows

To make sure this goes smoothly, the individual steps of the process are illustrated here - but it's actually very simple and usually doesn't take very long.
If you encounter difficulties with the installation at any point, please do not hesitate to contact us, with a brief description of what the problem is.

① Click on this link www.jRep.de/jRepE-Win.zip, or enter it into your browser (we recommend Opera www.Opera.com):

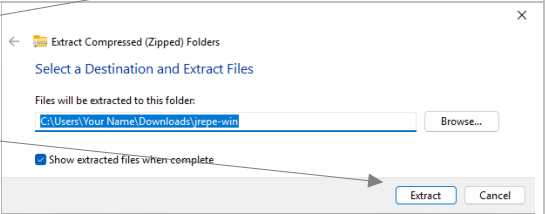
You can find the downloaded file in Windows Explorer , located on the left side within the **Downloads** folder.
Or you can access it by clicking the folder icon in the download dialog.



② We **right-click** the downloaded file and, in the **context menu** that appears, click **Extract All...**

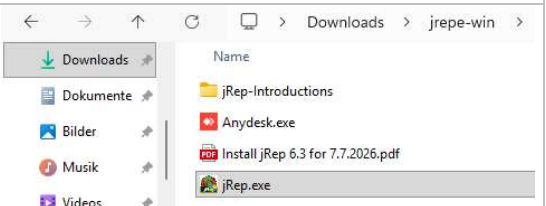
We confirm the specified target directory by clicking **Extract**

The files are now extracted and displayed in a new window:
the jRep program files, the jRep manuals, AnyDesk for remote support, this guide and the shortcut

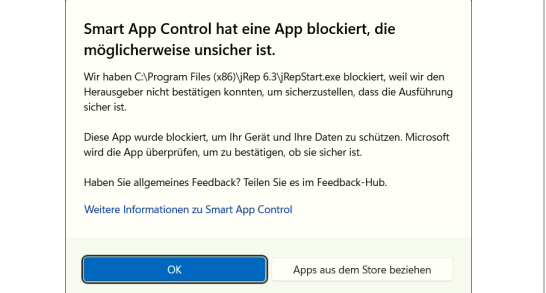


③ Now the files are extracted and displayed in a new window:
the folder with the jRep instructions, nydesk for remote maintenance, these instructions and the jRep installation file.

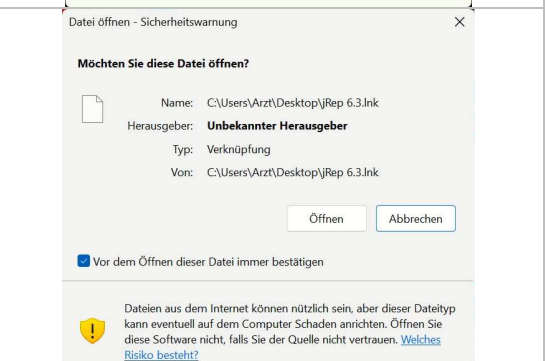
To install, we double-click on the **jRep.exe**



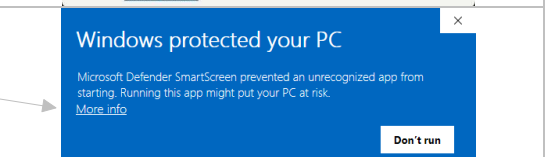
Should this notification appear, please repeat the installation process until it no longer shows up - seriously.
Alternatively, the feature can be disabled; however, this action cannot be undone. I haven't noticed any adverse effects as a result - after all, things worked just fine without it before.
To do this, navigate in Windows via Start > Settings to 'Privacy & security,' then to 'Windows Security,' then to 'App & browser control,' and finally to 'Smart App Control settings'. Here, you can proceed to disable the feature (Off).



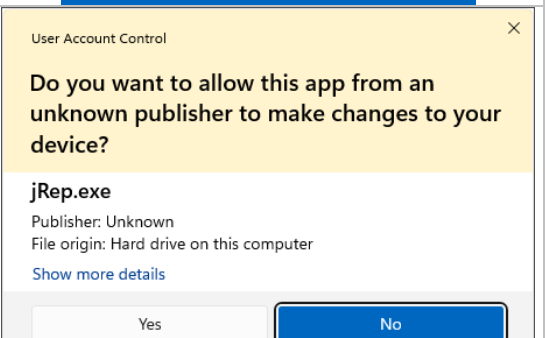
Should this warning or notice appear click on **Run** or on **Yes**



Should this notice appear click on **More Info** and then on **Run anyway**

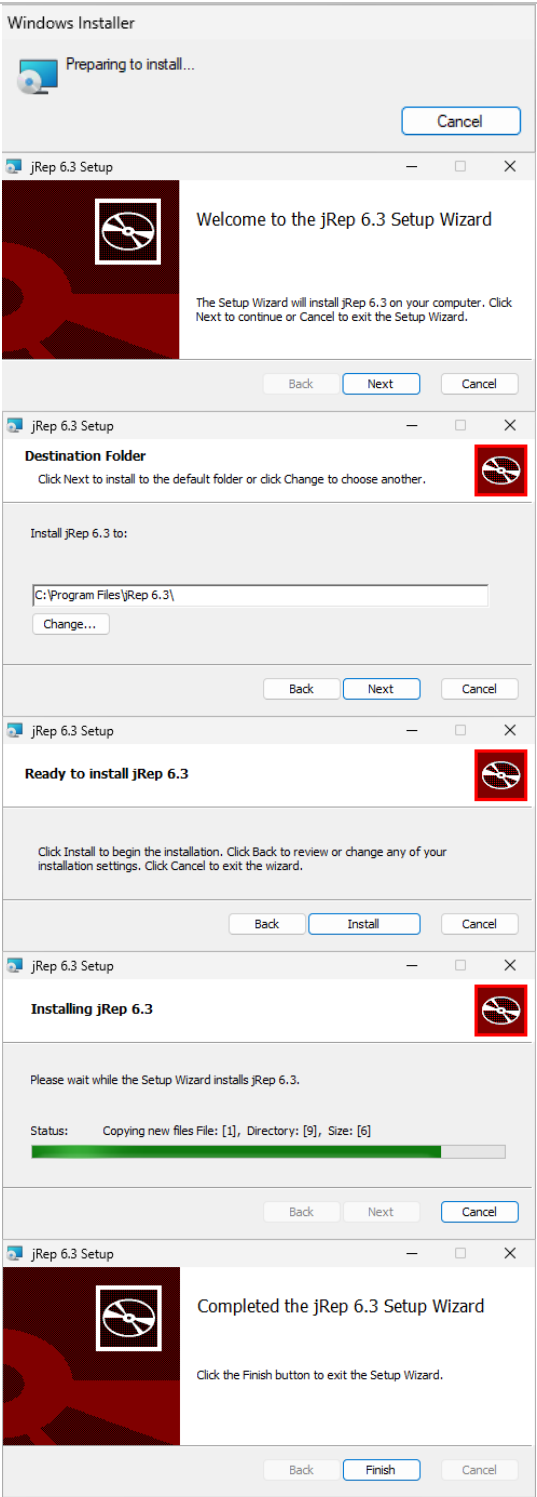


④ When prompted for User Account Control, we click **Yes**



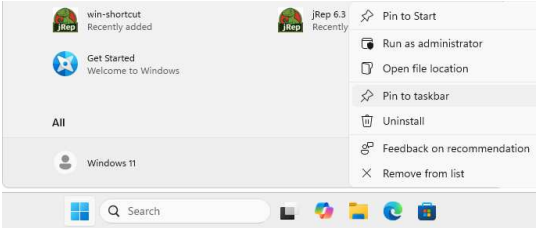

Then we click Next twice,
then Install and
finally Finish

Then we can close the windows and delete jrep-win.zip from Downloads.
If we now click Start, the **jRep shortcut** should appear in the Start menu.
Right-click it and select **Pin to taskbar** from the context menu that appears.
From there, we can easily start jRep 😊



When you first start the program up this dialogue box will appear:

Enter **your name** making sure there are no spaces after it.

A random **password** will be created to allow access to the patient list.

You can write this down or create your own.

Then we can select which window arrangement the program should start with.

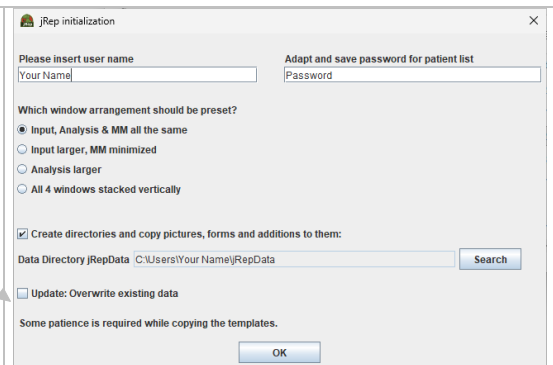
You should only change the default **jRep data directory** (jRepData) if you want to save the analyses, etc., centrally on a server or in the documents folder if this is backed up.

Then you create a jRepData folder on the server or in documents.

Then click 'Search', select the folder & click 'Open'.

For an **update** click 'Overwrite existing data' (If you have made changes to the repertories then back up your jRepData directory FIRST and contact me!)

Then click 'OK'.



The 'jRep initialization' dialog box contains the following fields and options:

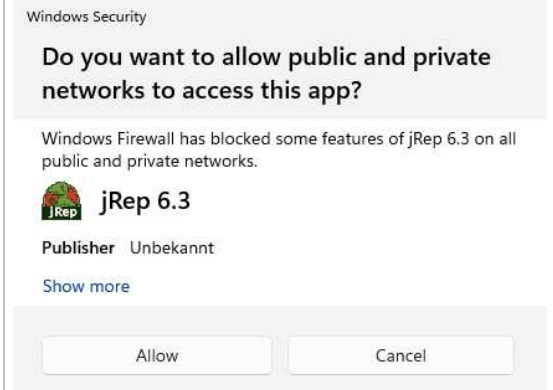
- Please insert user name:** A text field with 'Your Name' entered.
- Adapt and save password for patient list:** A text field with 'Password' entered.
- Which window arrangement should be preset?:** Radio buttons for 'Input, Analysis & MM all the same' (selected), 'Input larger, MM minimized', 'Analysis larger', and 'All 4 windows stacked vertically'.
- Create directories and copy pictures, forms and additions to them:** A checked checkbox.
- Data Directory jRepData:** A text field showing 'C:\Users\Your Name\jRepData' with a 'Search' button to the right.
- Update: Overwrite existing data:** An unchecked checkbox.
- Some patience is required while copying the templates.** A message with an 'OK' button below it.

It can take a moment until jRep starts up, as the external additional repertories and questionnaires, etc., are now being copied into our jRep data directory: jRepData.

Normally, there will be a query from your **firewall**, as jRep has its own web server for the forms.

In this instance, please click on 'Allow' or 'Do not block again' or similar.

When the program is started up for the first time, the **instructions window** will also open, which you can close with the ESC key or via the  top right corner and reopen if necessary via the 'Help - Instructions...' menu.

If the program doesn't fill the entire screen, you can resize the outer frame by holding down the left mouse button

or **maximize** the program window using the second icon in the top right .

If the windows have moved later, you can restore the internal windows default settings via the 'Window - Arrange All' menu or with ctrl+G.

To do this hold down the ctrl key (ctrl stands for control)

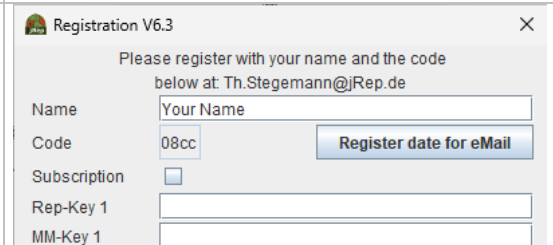
in the bottom left corner of the keyboard and then press the G key.

You can then release the keys again.

jRep can be used indefinitely with the Pneumonia Module, etc.

If you wish to test or purchase other modules, please navigate to the **Registration** via the **Help menu** and click on **Register Data for Email**

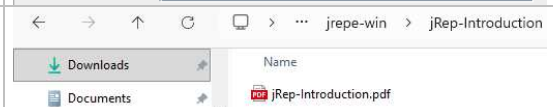
This copies the data to your clipboard, allowing you to paste it into an email using ctrl+V and send it to me. I will then set up a trial period or send you the activation keys.
